PETS Estimates 2024

OOH consult:

OOH Consultation Evening 6pm-10pm - dog/cat **£223.96**

OOH Consultation Night 10pm-8am - dog/cat **£271.11**

OOH Consultation Weekend 8am-6pm - dog/cat **£206.53**

OOH Consultation Bank Hol 8am-6pm - dog/cat **£223.96**

OOH Consultation Bank Hol 8am-6pm - rabbit/small pet/reptile/bird **£109.16**

OOH Consultation Evening/Night 6pm-8am - rabbit/small pet/reptile/bird **£154.26**

Initial fees: Consultation + overnight IVFT + comprehensive screening profile + hospital care (if stable): £900 - £1100

Injectable medications – approx. £30/injection, therefore £100-150 in addition overnight.

Subsequent hospital block (no meds/procedures included)

- Stable patient: approx. £400-£600 per 24h (*lower range only if on oral meds*)
- Unstable patient: approx. £600-800 per 24h
- Critical patient: approx. £800-1000 per 24 hours

Oxygen: £50 set-up + £120 per 12-hour period (+ unstable/ critical hosp, doesn't include nasal oxygen catheter/prong placement – approx. £60-80 in addition)

Blood transfusion: (including typing and additional IVC): £650-750 (+ unstable/ critical hosp)

Inpatient monitoring: £130 for Multiparameter + EPOC + repeat FAST/POCUS scans per 12-hour period

Radiographs: £300-800 (dependent on number of views and if sedation needed)

Referral ultrasound scan for inpatient +/- FNA + Lab fees: £700-1000 (+ hospitalisation)

Example Surgeries:

***surgery and anaesthetics only, not inclusive of stabilisation or hospitalisation**

1.5-hour GA + **Splenectomy** (simple to complicated) including ligasure 2000-2500

1.5-hour GA and **caesarean** (simple to complicated) including linear nerve block and Alfaxan induction £1500-2500

2-hour GA + **exploratory laparotomy**, including feeding tube and 5L flush:
£2000-3500

2-hour GA and **GDV** (simple to complicated) with gastropexy and feeding tube:
£2500 (*simple, no feeding tube*) - £4000 (*gastric resection, splenectomy using ligasure, NO/NG tube*)
